## **UDAAN Fellowship Programme**

#### **BACKGROUND**

Since its inception four decades back, Rambhau Mhalgi Prabodhini (RMP) as an organisation has emerged as one of the most trusted and reliable names in the development sector with unique and futuristic initiatives in education, training, public awakening, social-political research and international activities. RMP has been given the status of "Consultative NGO" by the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). This is the highest status granted by the United Nations to non-governmental organisations (NGOs).

RMP believes that lack of leadership in various sections of the society is what has been the biggest hurdle towards achieving welfare and equitable growth in the society along with making the world a safer and habitable place for the future generations to come. RMP has established the Indian Institute of Democratic Leadership (IIDL) which helps the youth of the country to develop leadership skills in tune with the democratic setup of governance. Every year 25-30 youngsters prepare themselves to become leaders after attaining a Post Graduate Programme in Leadership, Politics and Governance.

IIDL has joined hands with the reputed Manipal Educational and Medical Group (MEMG) to offer UDAAN Fellowship Programme to the bright, meritorious and socially motivated youths. The duration of the fellowship is 12 months, and MEMG has generously agreed to support each fellow with a monthly stipend.

## **Objectives of UDAAN Fellowship Programme**

Need for instituting a fellowship programme was felt to facilitate quality work experience in the field of leadership, management, politics, governance, democracy and public policy. It was envisaged that the fellowship will empower participants to get work experience in the socio-political sphere by close interactions with leaders, think tanks and related organisations in the above-mentioned domain. The core objectives of the programme are empowering fellows to actively participate in the political decision-making processes by connecting them with pertinent socio-political leaders, intellectuals and institutions. In the process provide the fellows with an alternative career option by honing their skills and expertise in governance.








## **Location Base of Current Fellows**

## **Fellowship Programme- Stages of Progression**

Following is the depiction of the stages of progression of UDAAN Fellowship programme followed by detailed information on each of the stages:



## Joining & Induction of Fellows

Fellows are welcomed to the programme. They are appraised of the process flow, expectations from them, dos and don'ts of the programme, reporting structure and frequencies and other procedural aspects of the Fellowship. Most of the Fellows joined the Fellowship Programme in October 2020.

## **Programme Overview through Fellow Handbook**

IIDL has developed a comprehensive and detailed handbook. This is given to all the Fellows after their induction into the programme. It helps them to get oriented and it to guide them throughout the fellowship programme spanning over 12 months. The "Fellow Handbook" provides all aspects of the Fellowship at a glance for easy reading and adherence by the fellows. It contains aspects such as introduction to the fellowship, its need and the goal, information on the governing team and the coordination team, training process, placement of fellows, reporting frequency and formats, periodic submissions by the fellows, their evaluation methods and procedures for completion of the Fellowship programme.







## **Organising Orientation Bootcamp**

IIDL organises orientation boot camp for all the Udaan fellows. This boot camp is important for Fellows as it provides insights on how the fellowship programme will be conducted, the code of conduct, reporting and other expectations from the participating Fellows. IIDL usually prefers in person and onsite meetings for such boot camps. However, due to the unprecedented situation arising out of COVID 19 pandemic, the boot camp has to be organised virtually. For the first batch of the fellows, IIDL conducted a three-day virtual orientation boot camp for all the UDAAN fellows from 16th October to 18th October 2020.

The boot camp helped in breaking the ice between the faculty of the programme and the fellows, as well as among the fellows, and would pave way for a conducive environment of learning during the 12 months programme.

Most importantly, the boot camp helped the fellows in understanding what should they expect, code of conduct while they are attached with the high-profile political leaders, do's and don'ts, reporting and their evaluation within the programme.

Some of the important areas and function on which the Fellows were provided training before attachment with mentors are:

- 1 Managing Self The lecture focused on how to manage oneself and bring out the best, to be able to contribute, wherever one is working
- 2 Power of Persuasion The lecture primarily focused on the communication at various levels, and how to make it effective
- 3 Office Management A very important aspect of the day-to-day work in the office of a public leader
- Emotional Quotient in Public Life This lecture focused mainly on the emotions in public life, and its management
- 5 Effective vs. Efficient This lecture focused mainly on how to increase productivity at work







## **Attachment of Fellows with Mentors**

This is the most important and critical learning stage for the fellows. They are attached to leaders of high-profile institutions and high-profile individuals in public life who handhold them to learn various aspects of leadership, teamwork, organisational activities and processes. Fellows develop their skills in areas like research, writing reports, communication, field activities and allied. Currently the fellows are individually attached to various mentors. These include MPs, MLA, Party Officer-bearers, think tanks and research organisations.

## **Periodic Reporting & Feedback Sessions**

While the Fellows were working with the offices of the political leaders that they were attached to, and were providing weekly reports, focusing mainly on the activities and the learning achieved. We were receiving individual reports, but it was also important to conduct a session on sharing of experiences and learning by the fellows in the initial one month of the fellowship.

In this regard, a two-hour session on "Sharing of Experiences, Learning and Feedback" was conducted by IIDL involving the Fellows on 6th November 2020. The session was very fruitful not only for the learning of the Fellowship, but also for IIDL as Fellows narrated the diverse experience and unique learnings each one had from the initial period of the Fellowship Programme. The discussion really was helpful from IIDL perspective also in terms of what tweaking is now required to make the programme even better. The experience sharing and feedback session will be conducted every month.




## **AMIT BALASAHEB DESHMUKH**
